

Take a Shot with St. Luke's COVID-19 Vaccine Mobile Unit

- This service and vaccine are free to the patients being vaccinated.
- Here's what to bring to your appointment: Insurance card and identification.
- St. Luke's COVID-19 vaccine mobile unit offers a couple of vaccine brands. If the vaccine you receive requires two shots, make sure you'll be available for the booster when the mobile unit returns (21 days for Pfizer or 28 days for Moderna). If you need a booster and you cannot come to the mobile unit, please call St. Luke's Connect at 208-381-9500 to schedule a booster at a St. Luke's location. You must have the same vaccine brand for the first and booster shots.
- **Limited mobility?** Even if you have limited mobility, you can be vaccinated at the mobile unit. Please stay in your vehicle and call 208-513-3413 when you arrive at the vaccination location and we will come to you.
